Book 1—The Life of Christ

A 114 page workbook covering the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. Also includes 40 pages of information on Bible customs.

Book 2—Genesis

An 86 page workbook covering topics like creation, the origin of the family, the origin of sin, the flood, the life of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and Joseph.

Book 3—Acts

A 113 page workbook covering the origin of the church, the ministry of the Holy Spirit, the sign gifts, and the growth of the New Testament church.

Book 4—Wilderness Wanderings

Coming in the fall of 2017, this study covers James, 1 & 2 Peter, 1, 2, & 3 John, and Jude. These books are packed with principles for Christian living.



The Need for the Approved Workman's Discipleship Course

Bible study has become more of a cliché than a spiritual habit for many who claim to be believers in Jesus Christ. Personal experience combined with anecdotal evidence suggests that the majority of self-professed believers in Christ spend more time eating each week than in meaningful time in the Word of God. Yet, a vast majority of believers would claim that the Bible is the most important book in the life of the believer.

The only way a believer will be successful in his Christian life is if he will immerse himself in God's Word. Attending a Bible-preaching church is important, but not enough to make a successful Christian life. Prayer is vital to the Christian life, but does not give us the knowledge we need to please the Lord with our life.

- ◆ How can one know he is going to heaven when he dies?
- ◆ Why can't we lose our salvation?
- ◆ Why don't we speak in tongues?
- ◆ Why is the local church so important?
- ◆ Why is marriage between one man and one woman?
